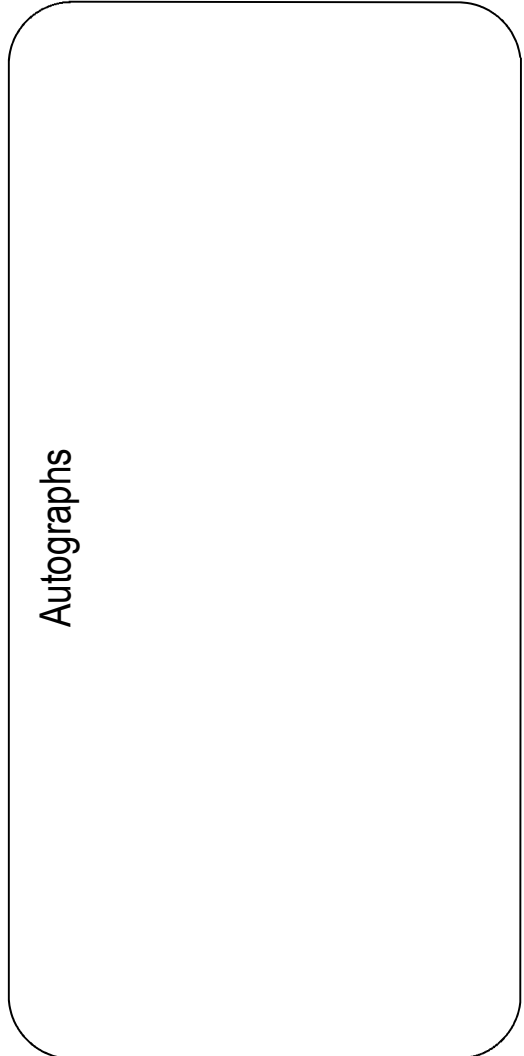

## The Venue

### The Royal Concert Hall

The Glasgow Royal Concert Hall was built to replace the St Andrews Hall at Charing Cross which burned down in 1962.

Architect, Sir Leslie Martin designed the Concert Hall and it was completed in a mere 864 days from when the first stone was laid in the late 1980s. Shortly after its construction in 1990, the venue was granted Royal status by HRH The Princess Royal. The Concert Hall is colossal in size and is a dominant landmark in Glasgow's cityscape.

Completed in 1990 when Glasgow was awarded European City of Culture, The Glasgow Royal Concert Hall is internationally renowned and stages a vast range of stage productions, concerts and celebrity guest appearances.

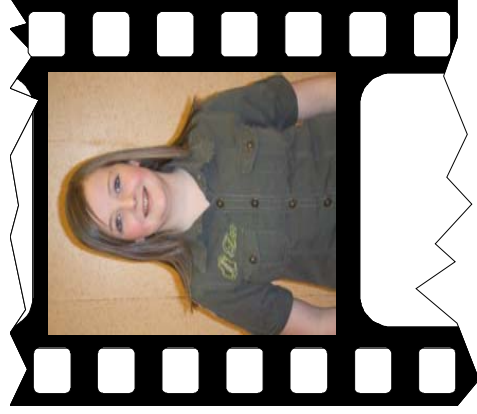

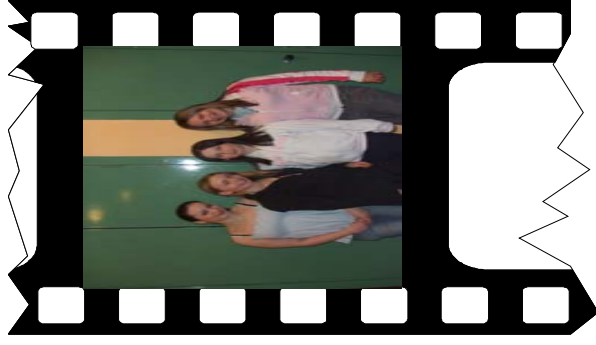
Led by 11 year old Caitlin Hill and her cousin Johnny Madden they produce melodic rock with a punky edge.
